- In 2021-22, the Vietnam Education Society (VES) completed the construction of two new kindergartens in rural Quang Tri province.
- Many thanks to the Ptarmigan Foundation and Bob and Mary Hagedorn for their generous donations.
- Opening ceremonies for both kindergartens were attended by VES President Carin Holroyd, Board member Ken Coates, her family, and the children and grandchildren of Bob and Mary Hagedorn.
- This brought the total number of VES kindergartens to 13, along with three primary schools and one primary school library in various provinces in north, central and south Vietnam.
